The Certified Peer Support Specialist (PSP) at Bill Kelly House provides purposeful resident-centered treatment coordination and supportive counseling through seamless partnership between staff members, residents, and their treatment plan. The PSP works to maximize resident treatment outcomes, quality of life, and Bill Kelly House experience by assisting residents in achieving their treatment goals, conducting social and recreational activities, providing crisis intervention, and communicating needs and outcomes to residents and other staff members. The PSP also works to empower residents to take ownership of their living situation by ensuring a clean and safe facility through room and chore inspection. The PSP will be assigned to supervise resident outings and facilitate group meetings as needed.

- Meets the qualifications for a Mental Health Practitioner as defined in the MN Comprehensive Mental Health Act of 1987
 - Has at least 6,000 hours supervised experience in the delivery of services to persons with mental illness;
 - Have at least 4000 hours of supervised experience in the delivery of services to persons with mental illness and an additional 2000 hours of supervised experience in the delivery of peer services to persons with mental illness.
- Valid driver's license.
