- Identifying community resources and developing relationships with community groups and agencies.
- Providing encouragement for involvement in community based activities such as: work, relationships, physical activity, self-directed hobbies, etc.
- Identifying barriers to participation in community activities.
- Supporting peers to connecting with professional supports and services
- Assisting in the development of a self-directed Recovery or Wellness Recovery Action Plans.
- Completion of required documentation
- The ability to work independently in a variety of settings, including the community and individuals homes.

- Current or former consumer of mental health services
- High School diploma or GED equivalent
 - Level II requires a Bachelor's degree in a Human Service related field and 1 year of experience working with adults with a mental illness
- Must have successfully completed the DHS Certified Peer Specialist training
- Excellent communication, good time management skills, and strong written, verbal, and computer skills
- Must have access to an automobile, a valid driver's license, and proof of auto insurance with minimum liability coverage level of \$100,000 per person and \$300,000 per occurrence
